Introduction

On October 18, 2018, the OEB issued its Decision and Order on Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc.'s (Enbridge) application for the Renewable Natural Gas (RNG) Enabling Program. In this Decision and Order, the OEB required Enbridge, among other matters, to: 1) file a draft rate order for Rate 401 (RNG Injection Service) and 2) establish one new variance account to record any annual sufficiency/deficiency of the RNG Injection Service and to file a draft accounting order.

OEB Staff Submission

On November 8, 2018, Enbridge filed an updated rate schedule for Rate 401 (RNG Injection Service) and a draft accounting order for the RNG Injection Service deferral account (RNGISDA).

OEB staff has not identified any issues with Enbridge's updated rate schedule for Rate 401 (RNG Injection Service).

OEB staff has noticed that Enbridge's draft accounting order states that the new account is a deferral account, not a variance account. However, based on Enbridge's description of this new account it appears to be a variance account as per the OEB's Decision and Order. OEB staff submits that Enbridge should update its draft accounting order to state that the new account is a variance account, RNGISVA, (instead of RNGISDA) and to file its revised draft accounting order with the OEB, and forward to the intervenors.
