DECISION AND ORDER

Bruce Power Inc. (Bruce Power) filed an application on September 19, 2018, with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) pursuant to section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act* (OEB Act), for a renewal of its electricity generation licence EG-2000-0271, which is set to expire on February 27, 2019. The licence authorizes Bruce Power to operate Bruce A and Bruce B nuclear generation stations owned by Ontario Power Generation Inc. and located in Tiverton, Ontario.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

After considering the application and assessing technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue the electricity generation licence to Bruce Power Inc.

The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
