IN THE MATTER OF the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998, being Schedule B to the Energy Competition Act, 1998, S.O. 1998, c.15;

ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD NOTICE TO CUSTOMERS OF NEWMARKET-TAY POWER DISTRIBUTION LIMITED

Newmarket-Tay Power Distribution Limited has applied to change its electricity distribution rates effective May 1, 2019.

If the application is approved, a typical residential customer in the Newmarket-Tay Power Rate Zone would see a decrease of approximately \$0.11 per month and a typical residential customer in the Midland Rate Zone would see an increase of approximately \$1.09 per month. Other customers, including businesses, may also be affected.

The requested rate increase is set using an OEB-approved formula which is tied to inflation and other factors intended to promote efficiency. Newmarket-Tay Power Distribution Limited has also requested approval to refund to customers the balances in certain deferral accounts.

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD WILL HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) will hold a public hearing to consider the requests made by Newmarket-Tay Power's in this application. We will determine whether the company has used the applicable models and formulas required by the OEB and whether to approve Newmarket-Tay Power's request to refund balances in certain deferral accounts. We will also hear questions and arguments from individual customers and from groups that represent Newmarket-Tay Power's customers. At the end of this hearing, the OEB will decide what, if any, rate increase will be allowed.

The OEB is an independent and impartial public agency. We make decisions that serve the public interest. Our goal is to promote a financially viable and efficient energy sector that provides you with reliable energy services at a reasonable cost.

BE INFORMED AND HAVE YOUR SAY

You have the right to information regarding this application and to be involved in the process.

- You can review Newmarket-Tay Power's application on the OEB's website now.
- · You can file a letter with your comments, which will be considered during the hearing.
- You can become an active participant (called an intervenor). Apply by December 13, 2018 or the
 hearing will go ahead without you and you will not receive any further notice of the proceeding.
- At the end of the process, you can review the OEB's decision and its reasons on our website.

The OEB intends to consider cost awards in this proceeding that are in accordance with the Practice Direction on Cost Awards and only in relation to Newmarket-Tay Power's request to dispose of the balance in a deferral account.


PRIVACY


