DECISION AND ORDER

RES Canada Energy Storage LP (RCES LP) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) dated October 24, 2018, pursuant to section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for an electricity storage licence.

RCES LP intends to own and operate Amphora 1 Battery Energy Storage facility, with an installed capacity of 3.96 MW, to be in service on January 14, 2019. RCES LP is seeking an electricity storage licence in order to provide frequency regulation to the Independent Electricity System Operator (IESO) administered grid through a Regulation Service Agreement with the IESO.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority, without holding a hearing, pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act.

After considering the application and assessing the technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue the electricity storage licence to RES Canada Energy Storage LP.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
