Lakeland Power Distribution Ltd.

Application for electricity distribution rates and other charges beginning May 1, 2019

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 2 December 13, 2018

Lakeland Power Distribution Ltd. (Lakeland Power) filed a cost of service application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on September 27, 2018 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B), seeking approval for changes to the rates that Lakeland Power charges for electricity distribution, to be effective May 1, 2019.

The OEB issued Procedural Order No. 1 on November 30, 2018, which set out a schedule for various steps in this proceeding.

On December 5, 2018, Lakeland Power filed a letter requesting the OEB delay the start of the settlement conference for one week, from February 19, 2019 to February 26, 2019 due to scheduling conflicts.

The OEB grants the request and the revised schedule is below. All other dates from Procedural Order No. 1 remain the same.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

 A settlement conference among the parties and OEB staff will be convened on February 27, 2019 starting at 9:30 a.m., at 2300 Yonge Street, 25th floor, Toronto. If necessary, the settlement conference will continue on February 28, 2019 and March 1, 2019.

- 2. Any settlement proposal arising from the settlement conference shall be filed with the OEB on or before **March 14, 2019**. In addition to outlining the terms of any settlement, the settlement proposal should contain a list of any unsettled issues, indicating with reasons whether the parties believe those issues should be dealt with by way of oral or written hearing.
- 3. Any submission from OEB staff on a settlement proposal shall be filed with the OEB and served on all parties by **March 19, 2019**.
- If there is no settlement proposal arising from the settlement conference, Lakeland Power shall file a statement to that effect with the OEB by March 4, 2019. In that event, parties shall file and serve on the other parties by March 8, 2019 any submissions on which issues shall be heard in writing, and for which issues the OEB should hold an oral hearing.
- 5. The OEB is setting a tentative date of **March 26, 2019** starting at 9:30 a.m. at 2300 Yonge Street, 25th floor, Toronto, for Lakeland Power to present to the OEB any settlement proposal and a summary of any unsettled issues in the case. OEB staff will, at the direction of the OEB, confirm or amend this date in subsequent correspondence.

All filings to the OEB must quote the file number, EB-2018-0050, be made in searchable / unrestricted PDF format electronically through the OEB's web portal at https://pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/. Two paper copies must also be filed at the OEB's address provided below. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at http://www.oeb.ca/OEB/Industry. If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a USB memory stick in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.

All communications should be directed to the attention of the Board Secretary at the address below, and be received no later than 4:45 p.m. on the required date.
