Energy Probe Research Foundation (Energy Probe) applies for intervenor status in the EB-2018-0130 proceeding, the application by Hydro One Networks Inc. to the Ontario Energy Board for an order or orders for approval of transmission rates and other charges beginning January 1, 2019.

Considering the scope of the application and its impact on customers of the Hydro One transmission system, Energy Probe believes that an oral hearing would be appropriate unless a settlement is reached on all issues.
