I, **Miriam Heinz**, of the City of Toronto in the Province of Ontario, MAKE OATH AND SAY AS FOLLOWS:


1. I am employed as Advisor, Regulatory Affairs, with the Independent Electricity System Operator (“IESO”) and as such have knowledge of the matters hereinafter deposed to.
2. On January 9, 2019 the Ontario Energy Board (“OEB”) issued the Notice of Application (“Notice”) for OEB proceeding EB-2018-0316 and by Letter of Direction (attached as **Exhibit “A”** hereto) directed the IESO, to undertake a number of steps.
3. Pursuant to paragraphs 1 and 2 of the Letter of Direction, on January 10, 2019 the IESO filed with the OEB a pdf version of the complete (dated) Notice (Dated Notice) in both English and French. A copy of the email sent to the OEB including confirmation of electronic filing through the OEB’s e-filing services is attached hereto as **Exhibit “B”**. Copies of the English and French versions of the Dated Notice are attached hereto as **Exhibits “C” and “D”** respectively.

4. Pursuant to paragraph 3 of the Letter of Direction, the IESO has made both the English and French versions of the Dated Notice, the application and the evidence available for public review at the IESO's head office reception, and on the IESO's Regulatory Accountability and Smart Metering Entity's webpages. Attached hereto as **Exhibit "E"** are the links and screenshots of the webpages that demonstrate this.

5. Pursuant to paragraph 4 of the Letter of Direction, on January 10, 2019 the IESO served a copy of the English and French versions of the Dated Notice and the application directly on:
 - a. all registered intervenors in EB-2016-0284, EB-2017-0290 and EB-2018-0143.
 - b. all electricity distribution companies that currently recover the Smart Metering Charge from eligible customers on behalf of the IESO.



LETTER OF DIRECTION

Dear Ms. Heinz:

Re: Application by the Independent Electricity System Operator, designated as the Smart Metering Entity, for approval to provide third-party access to certain data Ontario Energy Board: File No.: EB-2018-0316

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) has now issued its Notice of Hearing for the Independent Electricity System Operator (IESO)/ Smart Metering Entity's application for approval to provide third-party access to certain data (Notice). Please note that you must serve the Notice to the parties identified by **January 15, 2019**. If service is not possible by January 15, 2019, you must inform the Registrar immediately at Registrar@oeb.ca.

Further, the IESO had requested that the proposed draft Issues List be provided for comment along with the Notice. The OEB will address matters related to an issues list later in the proceeding.

You are directed:

1. To arrange immediately for the service of the enclosed English and French versions of the Notice, in the exact form accompanying this letter, except:
 - a. For the English version of the Notice, under the sections entitled "**BE INFORMED AND HAVE YOUR SAY**" and "**ORAL VS. WRITTEN HEARINGS**" remove the bold and bracketed words "[insert actual date 10 calendar days from the date the notice is posted on the applicant's website]"; and
 - b. For the French version of the Notice, under the sections entitled "**SOYEZ RENSEIGNÉ ET DONNEZ VOTRE OPINION**" and "**AUDIENCES ÉCRITES OU**

ORALES” remove the bold and bracketed words “[insérer la date, 10 jourssuivant la date de publication sur le site Web du demandeur]”; and

- c. In each of the English and the French version of the Notice, insert the same date which shall be determined by adding 10 calendar days to the date that each of the English and French versions of the Notice will be posted on the IESO’s website in accordance with the requirements of paragraph 3 below. If that date falls on a “holiday” as defined in Rule 6.02 of the OEB’s *Rules of Practice and Procedure*, insert the next date that is not a holiday. Use the following date format “**January 1, 2019**” for the English Notice and the following date format for the French Notice “**1 janvier 2019**”.
2. Once the requirements of paragraph 1 are completed, immediately and prior to completing any other steps required in this letter of direction, file with the OEB a pdf version of the dated Notice (Dated Notice).
3. To make a copy of both the English and French versions of the Dated Notice, the application and the evidence, and any amendments thereto, available for public review at the IESO’s offices and in a prominent place on the IESO’s website (Regulatory Accountability and Smart Metering Entity’s webpages).
4. No later than the date the Dated Notice is posted on the IESO’s website in accordance with paragraph 3 above, to serve a copy of each of the enclosed English and French versions of the Dated Notice and the application directly on:
 - a. all registered intervenors in EB-2017-0290, EB-2016-0284 and EB-2018-0143.
 - b. all electricity distribution companies that currently recover the Smart Metering Charge from eligible customers on behalf of the IESO.
5. To file with the OEB an affidavit in both electronic and paper forms proving completion of the matters in paragraphs 1 through 4 above immediately thereafter.
6. To provide a copy of the Dated Notice, the application and the evidence, and any amendments thereto, to anyone requesting the material.

You are further directed not to include any documents or materials when serving the Notice other than documents or materials expressly required by this letter of direction to be served.

ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD NOTICE

The Independent Electricity System Operator, in its capacity as the Smart Metering Entity, has applied for approval to provide access to certain non-personal data to third parties at market prices.

Learn more. Have your say.

The Independent Electricity System Operator, in its capacity as the Smart Metering Entity (SME), has applied to the Ontario Energy Board to amend its licence to enable it to charge market prices for access to certain non-personal data about electricity usage to third parties who meet the terms of access established by the SME and enter into a Data Use Agreement with the SME. The SME would provide the data on commercial terms. The SME would track the net revenues generated in a new variance account, which would ultimately be refunded to Smart Metering customers once a minimum balance has been achieved in accordance with the methodology approved in OEB Decision No. EB-2017-0290. The SME began collecting the data on January 1, 2017 as required by the Ontario Energy Board. Since that date, the SME has been consulting and working with stakeholders on providing third parties with access to the data.

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD IS HOLDING A PUBLIC HEARING

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) will hold a public hearing to consider the application filed by the IESO in its capacity as the SME. We will also hear questions and arguments from individuals and from groups that represent individuals. At the end of this hearing, the OEB will decide what, if any, requests will be allowed.

The OEB is an independent and impartial public agency. We make decisions that serve the public interest. Our goal is to promote a financially viable and efficient energy sector that provides you with reliable energy services at a reasonable cost.

BE INFORMED AND HAVE YOUR SAY

You have the right to information regarding this application and to be involved in the process.

- You can review the application on the OEB's website now.
- You can file a letter with your comments, which will be considered during the hearing.
- You can become an active participant (called an intervenor). Apply by **January 21, 2019** or the hearing will go ahead without you and you will not receive any further notice of the proceeding.
- At the end of the process, you can review the OEB's decision and its reasons on our website.

However, your personal telephone number, home address and email address will be removed. If you are a business, all your information will remain public. If you apply to become an intervenor, all information will be public.
