**PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1 on Combined Hearing
January 21, 2019**

On November 30, 2018, the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) received an application from Union Gas Limited (now operating as Enbridge Gas Inc.) (Union Gas) for the clearance of 2016 balances in certain Demand Side Management deferral and variance accounts. The OEB assigned file no. EB-2018-0300 to the application. On December 10, 2018, the OEB received an application from Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. (now operating as Enbridge Gas Inc.) (Enbridge Gas) for the clearance of 2016 balances in certain Demand Side Management deferral and variance accounts. The OEB assigned file no. EB-2018-0301 to the application.

Pursuant to section 21(5) of the OEB Act, the OEB decided that the applications will be heard together as a combined hearing. A Notice of Combined Hearing was issued on December 21, 2018. Each of Building Owners and Managers Association, Greater Toronto (BOMA), Canadian Manufacturers and Exporters (CME), Green Energy Coalition (GEC), Industrial Gas Users Association (IGUA), London Property Managers Association (LPMA), Ontario Sustainable Energy Association (OSEA) and Schools Energy Coalition (SEC) applied for intervenor status and cost eligibility.

No objection was received from either Enbridge Gas or Union Gas.

Each of BOMA, CME, GEC, IGUA, LPMA, OSEA and SEC are approved as intervenors. The list of parties in this proceeding is attached as Schedule A to this Procedural Order. Each of BOMA, CME, GEC, IGUA, LPMA, OSEA and SEC are eligible to apply for an award of costs under the OEB's *Practice Direction on Cost Awards*.

Cost eligible intervenors should be aware that the OEB will not generally allow the recovery of costs for the attendance of more than one representative of any party, unless a compelling reason is provided when cost claims are filed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. OEB staff and intervenors requesting information or material from Enbridge Gas or from Union Gas that is in addition to the evidence filed by each and is relevant to the hearing shall file written interrogatories with the OEB and deliver them to Enbridge Gas and Union Gas and all intervenors by **February 4, 2019**.
2. Each of Enbridge Gas and Union Gas shall file its responses to the interrogatories directed to it with the OEB and shall deliver those responses to all parties by **February 19, 2019**.
3. Unless the OEB orders otherwise, each of Enbridge Gas and Union Gas may file their argument-in-chief with the OEB and deliver it to all parties by **February 27, 2019**.
4. Unless the OEB orders otherwise, OEB staff and intervenors that wish to make written submissions shall file those written submissions with the OEB and deliver them to Enbridge Gas and Union Gas and all intervenors by **March 5, 2019**.
5. Unless the OEB orders otherwise, each of Enbridge Gas and Union Gas shall file its written response to the written submissions directed to it with the OEB and deliver the response to all parties by **March 19, 2019**.

All filings to the OEB must quote the file number, EB-2018-0300 / EB-2018-0301, and be made electronically through the OEB's web portal at <https://pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/>, in searchable / unrestricted PDF format. Two paper copies must also be filed at the OEB's address provided below. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at <http://www.oeb.ca/OEB/Industry>. If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.
