Newmarket-Tay Power Distribution Ltd.

Application for electricity distribution rates effective May 1, 2019

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 2 January 25, 2019

Newmarket-Tay Power Distribution Ltd. (Newmarket-Tay Power) filed an incentive rate-setting mechanism application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on November 9, 2018 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B), seeking approval for changes to its electricity distribution rates to be effective May 1, 2019.

The OEB issued a Notice of Hearing on December 3, 2018.

On January 24, 2019, Newmarket-Tay Power requested an extension to the date that it is to file interrogatory responses from January 31, 2019 to February 11, 2019, citing that the extra time is needed due to year-end resource constraints.

The OEB has considered Newmarket-Tay Power's request and grants the extension.

The procedural steps and dates below supersede those set out in Procedural Order No.

1.

It is necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding. The OEB may issue further procedural orders from time to time.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

- 1. Newmarket-Tay Power shall file with the OEB complete written responses to the interrogatories with the OEB by **February 11, 2019.**
- Unless the OEB orders otherwise, any written submission by OEB staff shall be filed with the OEB and delivered to Newmarket-Tay Power by February 28, 2019.
- 3. Unless the OEB orders otherwise, Newmarket-Tay Power may file a written reply submission with the OEB by **March 11, 2019.**

All filings to the OEB must quote the file number, EB-2018-0055 and be made electronically in searchable/unrestricted PDF format through the OEB's web portal at https://pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/. Two paper copies must also be filed at the OEB's address provided below. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at http://www.oeb.ca/OEB/Industry. If the web portal is not available, parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.
