Current energy rebates stipulate qualifications for home energy upgrades:

You need to be an Enbridge gas customer (you must pay your own bill) with a natural-gas heated home built before 1980. If you have a low income and your home was built after 1980 then Enbridge do not provide low income owners with any rebates to reduce their gas consumption. Now those low income people will be paying even more for gas consumption with no ability to reduce consumption through energy saving initiatives.
