I oppose to the price increase applied by Enbridge Gas Inc. to the Ontario Energy Board to raise its natural gas rates effective January 1, 2019.

My key argument is that regular gas prices at the gas stations have dropped from the neighbourhood of \$1.40 a year ago to less than \$1.00 per litre in recent weeks.
