INTERIM ORDER

Alexian Energy Services Inc. (Alexian Energy) filed an application on February 15, 2019, with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) pursuant to section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act* (OEB Act), for a unit sub-metering licence.

Alexian Energy was previously licensed by the OEB, and its licence expired on December 18, 2018. Alexian Energy is currently providing unit sub-metering services. In order to continue providing unit sub-metering services, the applicant requires a unit sub-metering licence pursuant to section 57 of the OEB Act. By letter to the OEB filed along with the licence application on February 15, 2019, Alexian Energy requested an interim licence.

Considering the time required to process an application in accordance with the OEB's established practice and procedures, and considering the applicant's need for a licence to carry out activities as a unit sub-metering provider, it has been found to be in the public interest to issue an interim order granting the unit sub-metering licence, pending the final disposition of the matter. This Decision & Order does not constitute a final decision on the application.

The applicant is reminded that it carries the onus of filing an application in a timely manner considering the OEB's typical timelines for processing licence applications. This licence is granted without prejudice with regard to any future compliance actions.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

A unit sub-metering licence is granted, on an interim basis, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence. The licence will be valid until June 30, 2019, or until the final determination of the unit sub-metering licence application, whichever is earlier.
