Energy Probe Research Foundation (Energy Probe) applies for intervenor status in the EB-2019-0002 proceeding, the application by the Independent Electricity System Operator to the Ontario Energy Board for approval of its 2019 Revenue Requirement, expenses and fees beginning January 1, 2019.

Statement of Interest

Energy Probe is a non-profit environmental and consumer organization which promotes economic efficiency in the use of resources.
