I would like to comment on this application for rate increases. Reading thru the material provided on this website, I appreciate the need for transparency to show the breakdown of this increase and where it is being allocated. My issue is that Enbridge is requesting administrative fees to manage this obligation for the Federal Greenhouse Act. As a consumer, we should not bear the cost of admin fees. In this case setting up accounts to capture this increase does not warrant a cost to the consumer. This is part of the accounting function within Enbridge and they will not be incurring any additional costs. As a consumer the admin costs need to be absorbed by the provider.
