Notice of Intervention of Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition (VECC)  
OEB File Numbers EB-2017-0224, EB-2017-0255 and EB-2017-0275**

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) is in receipt of your letter dated March 8, 2018, wherein you have requested late intervention status in the above mentioned proceeding due to changes with VECC legal counsel.

VECC's request for intervenor status is granted. The OEB agrees with VECC's proposal to accept the record as it currently stands. In granting the intervention request, the OEB requires VECC to adhere to the case schedule outlined in the OEB's Procedural Order No. 3 dated February 26, 2018. VECC should carefully review the procedural matters outlined in Procedural Order No. 3. The OEB reminds VECC that the date for filing interrogatories on the applicants' evidence has passed and VECC will not be provided an extension to file interrogatories related to the applicants' evidence in this proceeding. Similarly, the deadline for filing interrogatories on the evidence of Chris Neme that was filed by GEC has passed.

The OEB confirms VECC is eligible for an award of costs, subject to any objection from either Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc., Union Gas Limited, or EPCOR Natural Gas Limited Partnership.
