- RE: Cost Awards Process Review of Customer Service Rules for Electricity and Gas OEB File No. EB-2017-0183

On March 14, 2019, the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) issued a Notice of Amendments to Codes and a Rule. The OEB made a number of amendments to the Distribution System Code, Standard Supply Service Code, Unit Sub-Metering Code, and Gas Distribution Access Rule. In connection with these amendments, the OEB also issued a rate order to electricity and gas distributors that eliminated or clarified certain charges. These changes were made as a result of the OEB's review of its customer service rules and associated service charges for licensed electricity distributors, rate-regulated natural gas distributors and unit sub-meter providers.

The OEB made cost awards available to eligible persons under section 30 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* in relation to a number of activities during the course of the review. The OEB indicated that costs awarded, as well as the OEB's costs, would be recovered from rate-regulated licensed electricity distributors and rate-regulated gas distributors based on customer numbers.

During the course of this review, the OEB determined the following consumer representatives to be eligible for an award of costs in relation to cost eligible activities:

- Association of Community Organizations for Reform Now (ACORN Canada)
- Canadian Federation of Independent Business
- Consumers Council of Canada (CCC)
- Housing Help Centre
- London Property Management Association (LPMA)

- Low-Income Energy Network (LIEN)
- Ontario Chamber of Commerce
- Six Nations of the Grand River Territory
- United Way of Bruce Grey (UWBG)
- Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition

In its <u>Order</u> dated May 18, 2018, the OEB awarded costs in respect of preparation and attendance at stakeholder meetings in March 2018. This letter addresses costs relating to the following activities:

- The provision of written comments on the OEB Report dated September 6, 2018, to a maximum of 20 hours.¹
- The provision of written comments on the Notice of Proposal to Amend Codes and a Rule and Notice of Hearing dated December 18, 2018, to a maximum of 15 hours.²

Of the above consumer representatives, only CCC, LIEN, LPMA, and UWBG (Eligible Participants) provided written comments on either one or both of the above documents.

In order to determine the cost awards to Eligible Participants identified above, the OEB will use the process set out below.

- Eligible Participants shall submit their cost claims by April 1, 2019. The cost claim must be filed with the OEB and one copy is to be served, by e-mail, on each rate-regulated licensed electricity distributor and each rate-regulated natural gas distributor. The cost claims must be completed in accordance with section 10 of the OEB's <u>Practice Direction on Cost Awards</u>.
- Rate-regulated licensed electricity distributors and rate-regulated natural gas distributors will have until **April 11, 2019** to object to any aspect of the costs claimed. The objection must be filed with the OEB and one copy must be served, by e-mail, on the Eligible Participant against whose claim the objection is being made.
- The eligible participant whose cost claim was objected to will have until April 18, 2019 to file with the OEB a reply submission as to why its cost claim should be allowed. One copy of the reply submission is to be served, by e-mail, on the objecting party.

The OEB will then issue its decision on cost awards. The OEB's costs may also be addressed in the cost awards decision.
