LETTER OF DIRECTION

Dear Mr. Kitchen:

**Re: Enbridge Gas Inc.
Georgian Sands Pipeline Project
Ontario Energy Board File Number: EB-2018-0226**

On February 27, 2019, Enbridge Gas Inc. (Enbridge Gas) applied to the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) under sections 90 and 97 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* for leave to construct approximately 8 metres of Extra High Pressure and approximately 6.4 kilometres of Intermediate Pressure natural gas pipeline and associated facilities to serve the Georgian Sands planned subdivision in Simcoe County (Georgian Sands Pipeline Project).

The OEB has issued a Notice of Hearing for Enbridge Gas's application (Notice). The Notice will be published by the OEB, in accordance with directions to the OEB's agent which were copied to you. Please note that you must comply with the directions in paragraphs 2 and 3 below **prior to April 4, 2019**, which is the publication date of the newspaper in which the Notice will appear last. If you are unable to comply with the directions within this timeframe, you must inform the Registrar immediately at Registrar@oeb.ca.

You are directed:

1. To conduct a search of title forthwith, sufficient to determine the current registered property owners and encumbrancers with lands or interest in the lands directly affected by the proposed pipeline and related facilities.
2. No later than the date the Notice is posted on Enbridge Gas' website in accordance with paragraph 3, to arrange for the service of the enclosed Notice, in the exact forms accompanying this letter, and the application and the evidence, directly on each of the following:

- a. all property owners and encumbrancers with lands or interest in lands identified in the search of title referred to in paragraph 1 above
- b. the clerks of the County of Simcoe, Township of Springwater and Town of Wasaga
- c. all Indigenous communities that have been consulted or with lands or interest in the lands directly affected by the proposed pipeline and related facilities
- d. the Métis Nation of Ontario, Lands, Resources and Consultations Office, 66 Slater Street, Suite 1100, Ottawa, Ontario K1P 5H1
- e. all affected utilities, pipelines and railway companies
- f. members of the Ontario Pipeline Coordinating Committee

(Note: It is acceptable to serve a party with an electronic copy of the evidence, provided the party has stated its preference for the same.)

3. To make a copy of the Notice, the application and evidence, and any amendments thereto, available for public review at Enbridge Gas' office and in a prominent place on Enbridge Gas' website.
4. To file with the OEB an affidavit in both electronic and paper forms proving completion of the matters in paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 above, immediately thereafter.
5. To provide a copy of the Notice, the application and evidence, and any amendments thereto, to anyone requesting the material.

You are further directed not to include any documents or materials when serving the Notice other than documents or materials expressly required by this letter of direction to be served.
