In accordance with the Report of the Ontario Energy Board: Energy Retailer Services Charges issued on November 29, 2018 and the subsequent Decision and Order issued on February 14, 2019, ENWIN Utilities Ltd. (ENWIN) is advising the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) of its intention to opt out of applying the switch letter charge to energy retailers at this time.

In its decision, ENWIN considered the associated costs of implementing and maintaining this charge, and found that the costs outweigh the associated revenues from this activity. In accordance with the Board Report on Retailer Charges, ENWIN will notify the OEB when filing an incentive rate-setting or cost based application should it decide to commence applying the charge in the future.
