(Enbridge Gas) has applied to the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) for approval of the financial terms for 2019 and 2020 associated with the Open Bill Access program, including approval for the sharing of net revenues with ratepayers. The Open Bill Access program allows third-parties to access Enbridge Gas' bill for a fee to bill for services and provide marketing information. The program provides an annual benefit of \$5.389 million in rates to Enbridge Gas customers. The OEB has determined that it will consider whether the Open Bill Access program should continue, including the use of bill inserts, and if so under what terms.

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD IS HOLDING A PUBLIC HEARING

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) will hold a public hearing to consider the application filed by Enbridge Gas. We will question Enbridge Gas on the case. We will also hear questions and arguments from individual customers, from groups that represent the customers of Enbridge Gas, and from groups that use the Open Bill Access program. **At the end of this hearing, the OEB will decide whether the Open Bill Access program should continue and, if so, under what terms.**

The OEB is an independent and impartial public agency. We make decisions that serve the public interest. Our goal is to promote a financially viable and efficient energy sector that provides you with reliable energy services at a reasonable cost.
