

**Enbridge Gas Inc.**

**Application for a municipal franchise agreement with,  
and certificate of public convenience and necessity for,  
the Municipality of Arran-Elderslie**

**PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1  
April 8, 2019**

Enbridge Gas Inc.<sup>1</sup> (Enbridge Gas) is seeking an order of the Ontario Energy Board (OEB), pursuant to the *Municipal Franchises Act*, approving Enbridge Gas' proposed franchise agreement with the Municipality of Arran-Elderslie (Municipality).

The OEB issued a Notice of Hearing January 7, 2019. There were no intervenors or letters of comment filed.

It is necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding. Further procedural orders may be issued by the OEB.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

1. OEB staff shall request any relevant information and documentation from Enbridge Gas Inc. that is in addition to the evidence already filed, by written interrogatories filed with the OEB and served on Enbridge Gas Inc. and the Municipality of Arran-Elderslie by **April 15, 2019**.
2. Enbridge Gas Inc. shall file with the OEB complete responses to all interrogatories and serve them on the Municipality of Arran-Elderslie by **April 23, 2019**.

3. Unless the OEB orders otherwise, OEB staff may file any written submission with the OEB and serve them on Enbridge Gas Inc. and the Municipality of Arran-Elderslie by **May 3, 2019**.
4. Unless the OEB orders otherwise, Enbridge Gas Inc. may file a written reply submission with the OEB and serve it on the Municipality of Arran-Elderslie by **May 13, 2019**.

All filings to the OEB must quote the file number, EB-2018-0341, be made in searchable/unrestricted PDF format electronically through the OEB's web portal at <https://pes.oeb.ca/eservice/>. Two paper copies must also be filed at the OEB's address provided below. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at <http://www.oeb.ca/OEB/Industry>. If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a USB memory stick in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.
