DECISION AND ORDER

LEDdirect Inc. filed a complete application on January 28, 2019 with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB), under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for a unit sub-metering licence. The granting of this licence would enable the applicant to provide unit sub-metering services to consumers in Ontario.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority without holding a hearing pursuant to Section 6 (4) of the OEB Act.

After considering the application and assessing the technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds it to be in the public interest to issue a unit sub-metering licence to LEDdirect Inc. The OEB also finds that the term of the licence shall be for two years during which the applicant will have the opportunity to establish itself as a participant in the Ontario unit sub-metering sector. The OEB will assess the applicant's experience and performance in the marketplace should it choose to file for renewal of its licence in two years.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application for a unit sub-metering licence is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
