



Enbridge Gas Inc.

Application for a municipal franchise agreement with, and certificate of public convenience and necessity for, the Municipality of Arran-Elderslie

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 2 April 15, 2019

Enbridge Gas Inc.¹ (Enbridge Gas) is seeking an order of the Ontario Energy Board (OEB), pursuant to the *Municipal Franchises Act*, approving Enbridge Gas' proposed franchise agreement with the Municipality of Arran-Elderslie (Municipality).

The OEB issued a Notice of Hearing January 7, 2019. There were no intervenors or letters of comment filed.

On April 8, 2019, the OEB issued Procedural Order No. 1 which established a schedule to enable the OEB to obtain more information and to hear submissions relating to the applicant's proposed amendment to the 2000 Model Franchise Agreement.

On April 15, 2019, Enbridge Gas filed an update to its application. Therein, Enbridge Gas advises that it is now seeking OEB approval for a franchise agreement with the Municipality based on the 2000 Model Franchise Agreement, with no proposed amendments.

In the light of the April 15, 2019 update, the OEB no longer requires that written submissions on the application be filed. Accordingly, it is necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. The schedule set out in Procedural Order No. 1, relating to the submission of written interrogatories from OEB staff and the filing of complete written responses

from Enbridge Gas Inc. as well as submissions from OEB staff and Enbridge Gas Inc., is cancelled.

All filings to the OEB must quote the file number, **EB-2018-0341**, and be made in searchable/unrestricted PDF format electronically through the OEB's web portal at https://pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/. Two paper copies must also be filed at the OEB's address provided below. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at http://www.oeb.ca/OEB/Industry. If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a USB memory stick in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.
