**Application for approval to change gas distribution rates
and other charges effective January 1, 2020 to
December 31, 2024**

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 2

April 17, 2019

EPCOR Natural Gas Limited Partnership (EPCOR) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on February 1, 2019 under section 36 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B), seeking approval to charge new rates for the sale and distribution of gas effective January 1, 2020 and approval of an incentive rate-setting plan for the period January 1, 2021 to December 31, 2024.

The OEB issued Procedural Order No. 1 on March 22, 2019, that provided procedural timelines up to the presentation of the settlement proposal. The settlement conference is currently scheduled for May 15 and 16, 2019. This will be rescheduled to May 16 and 17, 2019. All other dates will remain as per Procedural Order No. 1.

It is necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding. Further procedural orders may be issued by the OEB.

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD ORDERS THAT:

1. A settlement conference will be convened on **May 16, 2019** with the objective of reaching a settlement among the parties. If necessary, the settlement conference will continue on **May 17, 2019**. The settlement conference will be held in the OEB's hearing room at 2300 Yonge Street, 25th Floor, Toronto, Ontario. starting at 9:30 a.m.

All filings to the OEB must quote the file number, **EB-2018-0336**, be made in searchable/unrestricted PDF format electronically through the OEB's web portal at <https://pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/>. Two paper copies must also be filed at the OEB's address provided below. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal

If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below.
