I am writing pursuant to the Board's Notice regarding the above proceeding to request intervenor status.

AMPCO's Interest

AMPCO is a not-for-profit consumer interest advocacy organization. AMPCO's members represent Ontario's major industries: forestry, chemical, mining and minerals, steel, petroleum products, cement, automotive and manufacturing and business consumers in general. AMPCO members are major investors, major employers and a major part of communities in which we operate, across Ontario.

AMPCO and its member companies are well known to the Board. AMPCO participates in many proceedings, working groups, consultations and initiatives of the Ontario Energy Board in which matters relevant to Ontario's large electricity consumers are being addressed. AMPCO has previously been approved by the Board in numerous Hydro One proceedings.

AMPCO's interest in the Board's regulation of distribution and transmission companies relates generally to the interests of consumers with respect to price/affordability, adequacy, reliability and quality of electricity service, and, more particularly, to how costs are allocated to, and rates are designed to recover costs from, industrial customers.

Hydro One's application reflects a Custom Incentive Rate-setting approach (Custom IR) for the period 2020 to 2022. AMPCO is intervening in order to ensure that the interests of its members are fully represented in the determination of just and reasonable rates. AMPCO seeks to review how Hydro One's plan balances the needs of the system, reliability, customer preferences regarding outcomes and rates and \$370 million in estimated productivity savings. AMPCO is also interested in reviewing the basis for Hydro One's proposed Custom Capital Factor to recover incremental revenue in each test year to support Hydro One's proposed Transmission System Plan.

We respectfully request that the Board please confirm AMPCO's eligibility for an award of costs in this matter. AMPCO has been granted intervenor cost awards in other OEB and Hydro One proceedings.
