

OM LIMITED PARTNERSHIP

**Application for a municipal franchise agreement with
Norfolk County**

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1

April 26, 2019

OM LIMITED PARTNERSHIP (OMLP) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on March 7, 2019 under section 9 of the *Municipal Franchises Act*, for an order approving OMLP's proposed franchise agreement with Norfolk County.

The OEB issued a Notice of Hearing on April 2, 2019. Enbridge Gas Inc. (Enbridge Gas) applied for intervenor status and no objection to the request was received from OMLP.

Enbridge Gas is approved as an intervenor. The list of parties in this proceeding is attached as Schedule A to this Procedural Order.

It is necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding. Further procedural orders may be issued by the OEB.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. Enbridge Gas Inc. and OEB staff may request any relevant information and documentation from OM LIMITED PARTNERSHIP that is in addition to the evidence already filed, by written interrogatories filed with the OEB and served on OM LIMITED PARTNERSHIP by **May 6, 2019**.
2. OM LIMITED PARTNERSHIP shall file with the OEB complete responses to all interrogatories and serve them on Enbridge Gas Inc. by **May 13, 2019**.
3. Enbridge Gas Inc. and OEB staff may file any written submission with the OEB and serve them on OM LIMITED PARTNERSHIP by **May 20, 2019**.
4. OM LIMITED PARTNERSHIP may file a written reply submission with the OEB and serve it on Enbridge Gas Inc. by **May 27, 2019**.

All filings to the OEB must quote the file number, EB-2019-0104, be made in searchable/unrestricted PDF format electronically through the OEB's web portal at <https://pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/>. Two paper copies must also be filed at the OEB's address provided below. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at <http://www.oeb.ca/OEB/Industry>. If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a USB memory stick in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.

All communications should be directed to the attention of the Board Secretary at the address below, and be received no later than 4:45 p.m. on the required date.
