



OM LIMITED PARTNERSHIP

Application for a municipal franchise agreement with Norfolk County

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 2 May 3, 2019

OM LIMITED PARTNERSHIP (OMLP) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on March 7, 2019 under section 9 of the *Municipal Franchises Act*, for an order approving OMLP's proposed franchise agreement with Norfolk County.

The OEB issued a Notice of Hearing on April 2, 2019. Enbridge Gas Inc. (Enbridge Gas) was approved as an intervenor.

On April 26, 2019, the OEB issued Procedural Order No. 1. In Procedural Order No. 1, May 20, 2019 was established as the date by which Enbridge Gas and OEB staff may file any written submissions. Due to the holiday on May 20, 2019, the date for Enbridge Gas and OEB staff to file any submissions is being revised.

It is necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding. Further procedural orders may be issued by the OEB.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

- 1. Enbridge Gas Inc. and OEB staff may file any written submission with the OEB and serve them on OM LIMITED PARTNERSHIP by **May 21, 2019**.
- 2. All other dates for procedural steps established in Procedural Order No. 1 remain the same.

All filings to the OEB must quote the file number, EB-2019-0104, be made in searchable/unrestricted PDF format electronically through the OEB's web portal at https://pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/. Two paper copies must also be filed at the OEB's address provided below. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the

document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at http://www.oeb.ca/OEB/Industry. If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a USB memory stick in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.

All communications should be directed to the attention of the Board Secretary at the address below, and be received no later than 4:45 p.m. on the required date.
