We are counsel to PUC Distribution Inc. ("PUC") with respect to the above-captioned matter. Pursuant to Procedural Order No. 1 dated April 4, 2019, written responses to interrogatories are due by May 17, 2019.

PUC is proposing to bifurcate its interrogatory responses in a manner consistent with the Board's determination in Procedural Order No. 2 to separate the mechanistic IRM portion of the application from the ICM funding request. Specifically:

1. PUC has been working diligently to have its responses to all the interrogatories prepared for filing by May 17, 2019. PUC expects to be in a position to respond to all questions relating to the mechanistic IRM portion of its application on time.
2. In relation to the ICM portion of the Application, there are a total of 139 interrogatories, consisting of 286 sub-parts and 395 individual questions. Given the high volume of ICM related questions to be answered, PUC will require additional time in order to respond. PUC is requesting an extension to file its responses to the ICM related interrogatories by May 31, 2019.
