INTERIM DECISION AND ORDER

NextEra Energy Marketing, LLC (NextEra) filed an application on March 27, 2019 with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) pursuant to section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act* (OEB Act), for an electricity wholesaler licence.

NextEra was previously licensed by the OEB, and its licence expired on March 26, 2019. In order to participate in the IESO-administered markets, the applicant requires an electricity wholesaler licence pursuant to section 57 of the OEB Act. Considering the time required to process an application in accordance with the OEB's established practice and procedures, and considering the applicant's need for a licence to carry out activities as an electricity wholesaler, it has been found to be in the public interest to issue an interim order granting the electricity wholesaler licence, pending the final disposition of the matter. This Decision and Order does not constitute a final decision on the application.

The applicant is reminded that it carries the onus of filing an application in a timely manner considering the OEB's typical timelines for processing licence applications. This licence is granted without prejudice with regard to any future compliance actions.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

An electricity wholesaler licence is granted, on an interim basis, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence. The licence will be valid until October 31, 2019, or until the final determination of the electricity wholesaler licence application, whichever is earlier.
