Ontario Energy Board (“Board”) File No.: EB-2017-0261 Scugog  
Island Pipeline Project (“Project) – Leave to Construct (“Application”)**

On May 31, 2018 the Ontario Energy Board (the “Board”) issued its Decision and Order which granted Enbridge Gas leave to construct the Project. In the Application for the Project, Enbridge Gas indicated that the Township of Scugog (the “Township”) and the Mississaugas of Scugog Island First Nation (“MSIFN”) intended to provide a voluntary financial contribution to the Project in the form of an Incremental Tax Equivalent (“ITE”). Enbridge Gas has recently been informed by the Township that the Township will no longer be providing a voluntary financial contribution to the Project in the form of an ITE. The MSIFN has also been informed that it will not be required to continue with its voluntary financial contribution to the Project.

Enbridge Gas has re-run the feasibility analysis for the Project to include the funding provided by the Access to Natural Gas Act and excluding the ITE contribution from the Township and MSIFN and can confirm the profitability index for the Project remains above 1.0.
