# RE: EB-2019-0049 Kitchener-Wilmot Hydro 2020 Rates Application Energy Probe Intervenor Request Letter

Energy Probe Research Foundation (Energy Probe) applies for intervenor status in the EB-2019-0049 proceeding, the application by Kitchener-Wilmot Hydro Inc. to the Ontario Energy Board for an order or orders for approval of electricity distribution rates and related matters effective January 1, 2020.

## **Statement of Interest**

Energy Probe is a non-profit environmental and consumer organization which promotes economic efficiency in the use of resources. Energy Probe will be representing its electricity residential customer supporters in Ontario, which we have some number of thousands, and will also be representing a broader concern with respect to the overall financial health and operational integrity of Ontario utilities.
