## **LETTER OF DIRECTION**

Dear: Mr. Kitchen:

Re: Enbridge Gas Inc. (Enbridge Gas)
Application for St. Laurent Pipeline Project
Ontario Energy Board File Number EB-2019-0006

On May 15, 2019, Enbridge Gas Inc. (Enbridge Gas) applied to the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) under s. 90(1) of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* for approval to construct approximately 1.7 kilometres of natural gas pipeline and associated facilities to replace the section of pipeline on St. Laurent Boulevard between Montreal Road and Donald Street in the City of Ottawa (St. Laurent Pipeline Project).

The OEB has therefore issued a Notice of Hearing for Enbridge Gas' application (Notice). The English and French versions of the Notice will be published by the OEB, in accordance with directions to the OEB's agent which were copied to you. Please note that you must comply with the directions in paragraphs 2 and 3 below **prior to June 19, 2019**, which is the publication date of the newspaper in which the Notice will appear last. If you are unable to comply with the directions within this timeframe, you must inform the Registrar immediately at Registrar@oeb.ca.

## You are directed:

1. To conduct a search of title forthwith, sufficient to determine the current registered property owners and encumbrancers with lands or interest in the lands directly affected by the proposed pipeline and related facilities.

- 2. No later than the date the Notice is posted on Enbridge Gas' website in accordance with paragraph 3, to arrange for the service of both the English and French versions of the enclosed Notice, in the exact forms accompanying this letter, and the application and the evidence, directly on each of the following:
  - a. all property owners and encumbrancers with lands or interest in lands identified in the search of title referred to in paragraph 1 above
  - b. the clerk of the City of Ottawa
  - c. all Indigenous communities that have been consulted or with lands or interest in the lands directly affected by the proposed pipeline and related facilities
  - d. the Métis Nations of Ontario, Lands, Resources and Consultation Office, 75 Sherbourne St., Suite 311, Toronto, Ontario M5A 2P9
  - e. all affected utilities and railway companies
  - f. members of the Ontario Pipeline Coordinating Committee

(Note: It is acceptable to serve the evidence by e-mail provided the party has stated its preference for the same.)

- 3. To make a copy of both the English and French versions of the Notice, the application and evidence, and any amendments thereto, available for public review at Enbridge Gas' office and in a prominent place on Enbridge Gas' website.
- 4. To file with the OEB, in both electronic and hard copy format, affidavit evidence proving completion of the matters in paragraphs 1 through 3 above immediately thereafter, with the relevant Notices and original post office registration receipts (where applicable), or courier confirmation lists attached as appendices.
- 5. To provide a copy of both the English and French versions of the Notice, the application and evidence, and any amendments thereto, to anyone requesting the material.

You are further directed not to include any documents or materials when serving the Notice other than documents or materials expressly required by this letter of direction to be served.
