This letter is in response to HQ Energy Marketing Inc.'s ("HQEM") request for late intervenor status in the above-referenced application. HQEM's intervention request was received by the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on June 5, 2019 after the deadline for filing such requests had closed.

HQEM states that as a transmission customer it has a direct interest in this application and that the outcome of the proceeding may have a substantial and direct affect on HQEM.

Hydro One Networks did not object to HQEM's request.
