Application for an Electricity Generation Licence Amendment

DECISION AND ORDER

Northland Power Inc. filed an application on May 23, 2019, with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) pursuant to section 74 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act* (OEB Act), to amend its electricity generation licence EG-2003-0103.

The requested amendment is to add to Schedule 1 of Northland Power Inc.'s electricity generation licence EG-2003-0103 the operation of 110 MW Kingston CoGen generation facility located at 5146 Taylor Kidd Blvd., Bath, Ontario. This facility is currently operated by NPIF Kingston Cogen Corp., a wholly owned subsidiary of Northland Power Inc. The applicant stated that the amendment is an administrative change. The Kingston CoGen generation facility is owned by Kingston CoGen Limited Partnership, and there is no change in the ownership of the facility.

Northland Power Inc. has also requested subsequent cancellation of an electricity generation licence EG-2007-0796 currently held by NPIF Kingston Cogen Corp pursuant to section 77(5) of the OEB Act.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

After considering the application, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the requested amendment to Northland Power Inc.'s electricity generation licence EG-2003-0103 and to cancel NPIF Kingston Cogen Corp.'s electricity generation licence EG-2007-0796.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Schedule 1 of Northland Power Inc.'s electricity generation licence EG-2003-0103 is amended to include the operation of Kingston CoGen generation facility located at 5146 Taylor Kidd Blvd., Bath, Ontario.
2. NPIF Kingston Cogen Corp.'s electricity generation licence EG-2007-0796 is cancelled.
