## Cost Claim of Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition (VECC)

The Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition (VECC) is an intervenor in the above-noted proceeding. We are in receipt of the corrected Decision and Order dated June 18, 2019. In that order the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) set the date of July 12, 2019 as the deadline for intervenors to file their cost claims.
