**EB-2019-0101: 2019 Federal Carbon Pricing Program Application**

**Re: Reply of EPCOR Natural Gas Limited Partnership**

Further to Procedural Order No. 1 dated May 1, 2019, EPCOR Natural Gas Limited Partnership (“ENGLP”) submits the following brief reply to OEB Staff’s submissions of June 24, 2019.

After ENGLP advised in its Interrogatory Responses<sup>1</sup> that it would seek disposition of its 2019 administrative costs as part of its annual Price Cap IR application (unless otherwise directed by the OEB), OEB Staff submitted that it:

“expects [ENGLP] will file an annual Federal Carbon Pricing Program-related application...[and] submits that [ENGLP] should dispose of the 2019 balances (which would include GGEADA, FCCCCVA, FCCFVA) as part of a future Federal Carbon Pricing Program-related application so that all FCCP-related costs and balances are reviewed in the same proceeding.”<sup>2</sup>

ENGLP has no concerns with OEB Staff’s submissions and, as noted previously, will await the OEB’s directions regarding the disposition of 2019 costs, whether it be through the annual Price Cap IR application, a Federal Carbon Pricing Program-specific application, or such other application or process as the OEB directs.
