



## **EPCOR Natural Gas Limited Partnership**

Application for gas distribution rates and other charges for the period from January 1, 2019 to December 31, 2028

## PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 2 July 12, 2019

EPCOR Natural Gas Limited Partnership (EPCOR Natural Gas) filed a custom incentive rate making application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on April 11, 2019 under section 36 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B), seeking approval for rates that EPCOR Natural Gas will charge for gas distribution, to be effective January 1, 2019 and for each following year through to December 31, 2028.

The OEB issued Procedural Order No. 1 on May 21, 2019, which set out an initial process for discovery of the evidence and scheduled a settlement conference.

On July 12, 2019, OEB staff filed a letter informing the OEB that the parties were not able to reach agreement on an issues list. OEB staff further recommended that the settlement conference scheduled to start on July 15, 2019 should be postponed. Accordingly, the OEB has decided to cancel the settlement conference until the OEB makes a determination on the next steps in the proceeding.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. The settlement conference, scheduled to convene on July 15, 2019 to July 16, 2019, is cancelled. The OEB will issue further procedural orders outlining the next steps in the proceeding.
