**Re: Hydro One Networks Inc.
Applications for Leave to Sell Distribution Assets to Bell Canada

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) received Hydro One Networks Inc.'s four separate applications under section 86(1)(b) for leave to sell distribution assets to Bell Canada on July 25, 2019. Due to similar nature of these applications, the OEB combined these applications and assigned one file number EB-2019-0191.

The combined application will be decided by an employee of the OEB who has been delegated this authority pursuant to section 6 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (Delegated Authority). The Delegated Authority intends to make a decision on the application without holding a hearing.

If required, OEB staff will contact you directly to seek clarification regarding the application and/or request additional information or material to complete the application. For these purposes, OEB staff may contact you by email, regular mail, or by telephone. Once your application is complete, the Delegated Authority expects to issue a final decision on your application within 60-90 days.

In the event the Delegated Authority decides to deny or otherwise modify the relief you requested in your application, you will be given an opportunity to provide comments. The Delegated Authority will consider your final comments, if any, prior to issuing a decision and order.
