Re: Imperial Oil Limited Application Number EB-2019-007 for Leave to Construct – Waterdown to Finch Project (the "Project")

With respect to Procedural Order No. 2, we respectfully request an extension until September 13, 2019 to provide written submissions. Therefore we request that the Procedural Order be amended as follows:

- 1. OEB staff and intervenors may file written submissions with the OEB and serve it on Imperial Oil and all intervenors by September 13, 2019.
- 2. Imperial Oil may file a written reply submission with the OEB and serve it on all intervenors by September 23, 2019.

The reasons for this extension are as follows:

- 1. Approximately 1,199 pages of responses to interrogatories were provided by Imperial on August 6, 2019. Additional time is needed to adequately review same.
- 2. Toronto hopes to use the additional time to seek agreements on various matters with Imperial, thereby reducing the scope of contested matters before the Board, and;
- 3. Toronto has engaged an expert to assist in responding to this Application. That expert will be largely unavailable during the period to August 16, 2019.

We have canvassed counsel for the municipal interventors (i.e. Halton, Mississauga, and Peel), and confirm that they support this request for an extension.
