Re: Alectra Utilities Corporation ("Alectra Utilities")
Incentive Regulation Mechanism ("IRM") Application for 2020 Electricity
Distribution Rates and Charges (OEB File No. EB-2019-0018)
- Clarification re Applicant Responses to MANA Interrogatories

We are legal counsel to Alectra Utilities in connection with the above-referenced application. This letter provides clarification regarding Alectra Utilities' treatment of the interrogatories that have been filed by MANA.

Procedural Order No. 1 defines the IRM and M-Factor elements of the application and provides for distinct interrogatory processes, with interrogatories on IRM elements being due by July 29 and interrogatories on the M-Factor elements being due by August 16. MANA filed one set of interrogatories on July 29 and another set on August 16. On reviewing MANA's initial set of interrogatories, Alectra Utilities found the focus to be on its Distribution System Plan, including the customer engagement elements of the plan. On that basis, Alectra Utilities determined that none of the interrogatories related to the IRM elements of the application. Instead, all related to the M-Factor elements. Consistent with Procedural Order No. 1, Alectra Utilities therefore intends to respond to both MANA's July 29 and August 16 interrogatories by September 13.
