**DECISION AND ORDER**

Hull Energy L.P. filed a complete application on June 28, 2019 under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for an electricity generation licence.

Hull Energy L.P. was formed in October 2016 to own and operate a 27 MW hydroelectric generation facility, known as Hull 2. The facility will be operating under a power purchase contract with the Independent Electricity System Operator.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority, pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

After considering the application and assessing technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue the electricity generation licence to Hull Energy L.P.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
