  - a) arrange for the service of each of the enclosed English and French versions of the Notice, in the exact form accompanying this letter and the application and the evidence, directly on all intervenors of record in B2M LP's previous transmission cost of service revenue requirement

proceeding (EB-2015-0026), namely the Society of United Professionals<sup>1</sup> and the Canadian Manufacturers and Exporters. Please also arrange for service directly on all intervenors of record in Hydro One Networks Inc.'s current transmission revenue requirement proceeding (EB-2019-0082), as well as all licenced transmitters in Ontario

2. To make a copy of both the English and French versions of the Notice, the application and evidence, and any amendments thereto, available for public review at B2M LP's office and in a prominent place on B2M LP's website.
3. To file with the OEB an affidavit in both electronic and paper forms proving completion of the matters in paragraphs 1 through 2 above immediately thereafter.
4. To provide a copy of the Notice, application and evidence, and any amendments thereto, to anyone requesting the material.

You are further directed not to include any documents or materials when serving the Notice other than documents or materials expressly required by this letter of direction to be served.
