Dear Ms. Walli:

In response to interrogatory AMPCO-40, EnWin filed three attachments related to commercial negotiations with a customer that were filed in confidence.

In accordance with the OEB's Practice Direction on Confidential Filings, EnWin has provided reasons for the confidentiality request, including reasons why public disclosure of the information would be contrary to the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act. EnWin submits that the disclosure of these documents would prejudice that customer's negotiating position. EnWin also submits that disclosure could reasonably be expected to prejudice the economic interest and competitive position of, cause undue financial loss to, and be injurious to the financial interest of the customer.

In addition, EnWin filed a letter¹ from the customer that requested that the communications between EnWin and the customer, included in the confidential attachments to AMPCO-40, be kept confidential as it relates to previous negotiations and could affect the competitive position of the customer in the market if it is disclosed to the public.

AMPCO agrees that the attachments contain commercially sensitive information about the customer. AMPCO supports EnWin's request for confidential treatment.
