
I, MARYANNE WILSON, at the Town of Oakville, make oath and say:


1. I am the Director, Regulatory and Compliance at Oakville Hydro Electricity Distribution Inc. ("Oakville Hydro") and, as such, have knowledge of the matters hereinafter referred to.
2. In accordance with the directives contained in the Ontario Energy Board's (the "OEB's") Letter of Direction, dated August 28, 2019, Oakville Hydro has completed the following items:
 - a. Inserted a date of September 9, 2019 into the sections of the Notice specified in paragraph one of the Letter of Direction. September 9, 2019 being the date that is 10 calendar days after the date that Oakville Hydro posted the Notice of Hearing (the "Notice") on its website; as determined in accordance with paragraph five of the Letter of Direction.
 - b. Filed a pdf version of the dated Notice through the OEB's Regulatory Electronic Submission System (RESS). Attached hereto as Exhibit A to this affidavit is a copy of the Notice.
 - c. Posted the dated Notice on Oakville Hydro's website on August 29, 2019.

ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD NOTICE TO CUSTOMERS OF OAKVILLE HYDRO ELECTRICITY DISTRIBUTION INC.

Oakville Hydro Electricity Distribution Inc. applied to raise its electricity distribution rates effective January 1, 2020.

Oakville Hydro Electricity Distribution Inc. applied to the Ontario Energy Board to raise its electricity distribution rates effective January 1, 2020. If the application is approved, a typical residential customer of Oakville Hydro Electricity Distribution Inc. would see an increase of approximately \$0.64 per month. Other customers, including businesses, may also be affected.

The requested rate increase is set using an OEB-approved formula which is tied to inflation and other factors intended to promote efficiency. The rate increase also includes Oakville Hydro Electricity Distribution Inc.'s request for incremental capital funding for the construction of certain System Access projects.

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD WILL HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) will hold a public hearing to consider Oakville Hydro's request. We will determine whether the company has used the applicable models and formulas required by the OEB and whether to approve Oakville Hydro's request for incremental funding. We will also hear questions and arguments from individual customers and from groups that represent Oakville Hydro's customers. At the end of this hearing, the OEB will decide what, if any, rate increase will be allowed.

The OEB is an independent and impartial public agency. We make decisions that serve the public interest. Our goal is to promote a financially viable and efficient energy sector that provides you with reliable energy services at a reasonable cost.

BE INFORMED AND HAVE YOUR SAY

You have the right to information regarding this application and to be involved in the process.

- You can review Oakville Hydro's application on the OEB's website now.
- You can file a letter with your comments, which will be considered during the hearing.
- You can become an active participant (called an intervenor). Apply by September 9, 2019 or the hearing will go ahead without you and you will not receive any further notice of the proceeding.
- At the end of the process, you can review the OEB's decision and its reasons on our website.

The OEB intends to consider cost awards in this proceeding that are in accordance with the *Practice Direction on Cost Awards* and only in relation to Oakville Hydro's request for incremental capital funding.

These proposed charges relate to Oakville Hydro's distribution services. They make up part of the Delivery line - one of the five line items on your bill. If you write a letter of comment, your name and the content of your letter will be put on the public record and the OEB website. However, your personal telephone number, home address and email address will be removed. If you are a business, all your information will remain public. If you apply to become an intervenor, all information will be public.

This rate hearing will be held under section 78 of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998, S.O. 1998, c.15 (Schedule B).
