LETTER OF DIRECTION

Dear Mr. Skworchinski:

Re: Corporation of the Town of Marathon (Town of Marathon) North Shore LNG Project Ontario Energy Board File Number: EB-2018-0329

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) has issued a Notice of Hearing for the Town of Marathon's above referenced application (Notice). The English and French versions of the Notice will be published by the OEB in multiple newspapers, in accordance with directions to the OEB's agent which were copied to you. Please note that you must comply with the directions in paragraphs 2 through 4 below **prior to September 18**, **2019**, which is the publication date of the newspaper in which the Notice will appear last. If you are unable to comply with the directions within this timeframe, you must inform the Registrar immediately at <u>Registrar@oeb.ca</u>.

You are directed:

- To conduct a search of title forthwith, sufficient to determine the current registered property owners and encumbrancers with lands or interest in the lands directly affected by the proposed pipeline and associated facilities.
- 2. No later than the date the Notices are posted on the Town of Marathon's website in accordance with paragraph 4, to arrange for the service of the enclosed Notices, in the exact forms accompanying this letter, and the application and the evidence, directly on all property owners and encumbrancers with lands or interest in lands identified in the search of title referred to in paragraph 1 above.

- 3. No later than the date the Notices are posted on the Town of Marathon's website in accordance with paragraph 4, to arrange for the service of each of the enclosed Notices, in the exact form accompanying this letter and the application directly on the following:
 - a. the clerks of the Town of Marathon, the Township of Manitouwadge, the Township of Terrace Bay, Township of Schreiber and the Municipality of Wawa
 - b. all Indigenous communities that have been consulted or with lands or interest in the lands directly affected by the proposed pipeline and related facilities
 - c. the Métis Nation of Ontario, Lands, Resources and Consultations Office, 66 Slater Street, Suite 1100, Ottawa, Ontario K1P 5H1
 - d. all affected utilities, pipelines and railway companies
 - e. members of the Ontario Pipeline Coordinating Committee
 - f. all rate-regulated natural gas utilities
 - g. Northeast Midstream LP.

(Note: It is acceptable to serve a party with an electronic copy of the evidence by e-mail, provided the party has stated its preference in writing for the same. If you choose to email a party, please request a read-receipt prior to sending the email.)

- 4. To make a copy of the all of the enclosed Notices, the application and the evidence, and any amendments thereto, available for public review at the offices and in a prominent place on the websites of the Town of Marathon, Township of Manitouwadge, Township of Schreiber, Township of Terrace Bay and Municipality of Wawa.
- 5. To file with the OEB an affidavit in both electronic and paper forms proving completion of the matters in paragraphs 1 through 4, immediately thereafter with the relevant Notices and original post office registration receipts (where applicable), or courier confirmation lists attached as appendices.
- 6. To provide a copy of the English and French versions of the Notice, the application and evidence, and any amendments thereto, to anyone requesting the material.

You are further directed not to include any documents or materials when serving the Notice other than documents or materials expressly required by this letter of direction to be served.
