**Re: Eacom Timber Corporation  
Application for Electricity Wholesaler Licence  
OEB File Number EB-2019-0226**

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) received Eacom Timber Corporation's (Eacom) application for an electricity wholesaler licence on September 10, 2019. The OEB has assigned file number EB-2019-0226 to the application. The application will be decided by an employee of the OEB who has been delegated this authority pursuant to section 6 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (Delegated Authority). The Delegated Authority intends to make a decision on the application without holding a hearing.

The OEB has preliminary reviewed your application. Your application is currently incomplete and cannot be processed until the following has been filed:

## **1. Section 6: Applicant's Licensing Status and History**

In this section, the applicant indicated that Eacom does not have a previous licencing history. However, according to the IESO website, Eacom is listed as an active market participant, which means that Eacom contravenes section [57](#) (e) of the OEB Act that states that no person can purchase electricity or ancillary services in the IESO-administered markets without an OEB licence.

Please explain when Eacom began purchasing power in the IESO-administered markets, and provide reasons why Eacom has not applied for an electricity wholesaler licence prior to entering the market.

## **2. Section 9: Corporate Organization**

Please provide a corporate organization chart for the applicant.

## **3. Section 10: Finance**

In support of its financial position, Eacom has not provided any financial information.

As required in Section 10-Finance, please provide audited financial statements for the last two years. If audited financial statements are not available, please provide unaudited financial statements signed by the key individual.

## **4. Section 13: Key Individual Information**

Each key individual identified in section 7 is required to fill out section 13, as well as sign and date this form. With its application, Eacom only filed a completed section 13 for Mr. Patrick Belisle. Please file a completed section 13 for the other two key individuals, Mr. Kevin Edgson and Mr. Wade Zammit.

The OEB will resume processing your application once the above information has been filed. If the above information is not filed within 30 days of the date of this letter, the OEB may close the file for this application.

Once your application is complete, the Delegated Authority expects to issue a final decision on your application within 60-90 days.

In the event the Delegated Authority decides to deny or otherwise modify the relief you requested in your application, you will be given an opportunity to provide comments. The Delegated Authority will consider your final comments, if any, prior to issuing a decision and order.
