



EPCOR Natural Gas Limited Partnership

Application for gas distribution rates and other charges for the period from January 1, 2019 to December 31, 2028

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 5 September 20, 2019

EPCOR Natural Gas Limited Partnership (EPCOR Southern Bruce) filed a custom incentive rate-setting application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on April 11, 2019 under section 36 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B), seeking approval for rates that EPCOR Southern Bruce charges for gas distribution, to be effective January 1, 2019 and for each following year through to December 31, 2028. EPCOR Southern Bruce has proposed to provide first-time natural gas service within certain communities in South Bruce.

A settlement conference was held between the intervenors and the applicant on August 21 and 22, 2019 to reach a settlement on the issues in the proceeding. EPCOR Southern Bruce filed a settlement proposal on September 13, 2019 and a revised settlement proposal was filed on September 16, 2019.

In Procedural Order No. 3, the OEB scheduled September 24, 2019 as a tentative date for EPCOR Southern Bruce to present to the OEB any settlement proposal and a summary of any unsettled issues in the case. The OEB has determined that it does not require EPCOR Southern Bruce to present the settlement proposal. Accordingly, the presentation day scheduled for September 24, 2019 is cancelled. The OEB will issue further procedural direction in due course.

It is necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding. Further procedural orders may be issued by the OEB.

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD ORDERS THAT:

1. The presentation of the settlement proposal scheduled for September 24, 2019, is cancelled.
