**RE: EB-2019-0172 Enbridge Gas Inc. Windsor Pipeline Replacement Project  
Energy Probe Intervenor Request Letter**

Energy Probe Research Foundation (Energy Probe) applies for intervenor status in the EB-2019-0172 proceeding, the application by Enbridge Gas Inc. to the Ontario Energy Board for the approval of its Windsor Pipeline Replacement Project.

### **Statement of Interest**

Energy Probe is a non-profit environmental and consumer organization which promotes economic efficiency in the use of resources. Energy Probe will be representing its natural gas residential and small commercial customer supporters in Ontario, which we have some number of thousands, and will also be representing a broader concern with respect to the overall financial health and operational integrity of Ontario utilities. If its intervention is approved, Energy Probe expects to focus on the cost estimates for the Windsor Pipeline Replacement Project, particularly on the allocation of overhead costs and the estimate of contingency. Energy Probe was an active participant in recent Enbridge proceedings, EB-2017-0306/0307, EB-2018-0105, EB-2018-0131 and EB-2018-0305 and hopes that its participation in the EB-2019-0172 proceeding will be of assistance to the Board.

### **Hearing**

Energy Probe hopes that all issues can be resolved through settlement negotiations and that a hearing will not be necessary. However, if a hearing is required, Energy Probe plans to be an active participant in the hearing, whether it is in oral or written form.
