Re: EB-2019-0185 - NOVA Chemicals (Canada) Ltd. (NCCL) Application for *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998 (OEB Act)* section 57(e) (Electricity Wholesale) Licence.

Update on Third Party Contacts.

By letter dated July 19, 2019 we submitted NCCL's application for Electricity Wholesale Licence renewal, and an explanation of the context in which that application was submitted. That context included mention of 4 third parties – Trans Alta, INEOS Styrolution Canada Limited (INEOS), Performance Science Materials Company (PSMC) and Suncor – who are in some way associated with NCCL's electricity arrangements (as supplier, consumer or shared services participant). In our July 19th letter we advised that NCCL had provided a copy of that letter to each of these parties and was following up with each to confirm that they had no concerns with the application or the July 19th transmittal letter with which it was filed. We undertook to update the Board on the outcome of those contacts.

By *Decision and Order* dated August 15, 2019 the Board accepted NCCL's application and granted it Electricity Wholesaler Licence EW-2019-0185.

To complete the record on this matter, we write to confirm for the Board that NCCL's follow-ups are complete and none of the parties noted above raised any concerns with NCCL's application or the transmittal letter with which it was filed.
