We received your letter regarding the Goldcorp Canada Ltd.'s application for an application for an electricity wholesaler licence dated October 16, 2019. The OEB file number for this application is EB-2019-0222.

This letter is in response to the queries in the letter.

1. Section 6, Page 3: Applicant's Licensing Status and History

Red Lakes Gold Mines has allowed the license to expire due to personnel turnover. It is unfortunate that this transpired, and steps are taken to prevent this from re-occurring.

2. Section 9, Page 6: Corporate Organization

A simplified corporate organizational chart is shown in Figure 1. For the full legal organogram please refer to the attachment "Organogram Goldcorp.PDF". The Newmont Goldcorp group of entities own 100% of Goldcorp Canada Ltd.

3. Section 12(e), Page 8: Legal and Regulatory Proceedings

Goldcorp Canada Ltd pleaded guilty and was fined on July 22, 2015 after an incident in which a mine worker was injured at Red Lake Gold Mines. The details are included in the attachment called "injury-atgoldcorp-canada-results-in-100000-fine.doc".
