Re: **Corporation of the Town of Marathon  
North Shore LNG Project  
Ontario Energy Board File Number: EB-2018-0329**

On October 17, 2019, Anwaatin Inc. (Anwaatin) filed with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) an intervention request in the above noted proceeding. By letter dated October 21, 2019, the OEB advised Anwaatin that the OEB would reject its request for intervenor standing absent the provision of additional information by October 24, 2019.

On October 24, 2019, the Corporation of the Town of Marathon (Corporation) filed a letter requesting an extension to the date by which submissions must be filed on additional information filed by Anwaatin. In its letter, the Corporation explained that it assumed that the deadline prescribed in the OEB's *Rules of Practice and Procedure* for the receipt of objections to a request for standing is five (5) business days from the due date of the additional information, or October 31, 2019. If, however, the five-day deadline is to be calculated from the date of Anwaatin's original intervention request, then the due date for the Corporation's response was October 24, 2019. If the latter is true, then the Corporation requests that this deadline be extended to October 29, 2019. The extension is necessary in order to allow the Corporation time to determine its position with regard to the additional information filed by Anwaatin.

The OEB panel has considered the Corporation's request and will grant the extension. The Corporation's submissions on Anwaatin's request for intervenor status and additional information are due on **October 28, 2019**.
